

Altona, Bradford, Duncan, Galva, Princeville, Putnam, Speer, Toulon & Wyoming General Grain Policies

September 1, 2024

All grain must be declared as SPOT, CONTRACT, DELAY PRICE at time of delivery or it will be considered put into STORAGE.

GRAIN DISCOUNTS All grain will be discounted on a load-by-load basis. Each load will be probed

to get a representative sample. If necessary, pit samples may be taken, and any load found to contain excessive variations in any grade factor will be graded per the higher grade. The current scale of discounts will apply. The seller has the option of requesting official grades by a federal grain inspector on any contested sample. The seller shall stand all costs of such grades and these grades will be

final.

CASH SELLING Grain that is delivered and sold as "spot" will be priced using the closing price

at the end of the day unless otherwise specified. Other contract alternatives:

Basis Contracts:

Initiation Fee: 0 Rolling Fee: 2 cents/bushel per roll +/- the spread

HTA Contracts (5,000-bushel increments):

Inquire regarding current fees to apply.

Fees will be deducted from the contracted futures price

Rolling Fee: 2 cents/bushel +/- the spread (no rolling between crop years)

GRAIN CHECKS Grain checks will be issued in the name of the entity identified on the scale

ticket, and lienholder if applicable. A Grain Transfer Authorization Form must be completed if grain proceeds are to be paid to another entity. This entity must

have an approved account with RVC prior to any payment.

WAREHOUSE RECEIPTS Grain to be stored at River Valley Cooperative will be put on Open Storage.

Negotiable Receipts for loan purposes must have all discounts and fees along

with 9 months of storage paid up front.

DEFER PAYMENTS River Valley Cooperative will offer producers the ability to defer the payment

on grain sold. Payment can be deferred up to 15 months.

TREATED GRAIN Federal law prohibits commingling of treated seed with commercial grain and

does not allow any tolerance for treated seed in grain. All treated seed should be

kept well separated from commercial grain inventories.

GMO VARIETIES RVC requires notification prior to delivery of any grain that contains transgenic

events not approved for US export markets. RVC reserves the right to refuse delivery of grain that contains unapproved traits, as not all RVC facilities will

accept varieties not approved for export.

2024 Grain Programs

STORAGE PROGRAMS

CORN STORAGE CHARGES

Minimum Charge - 16 cents/bushel to December 1, 2024.

Thereafter, 4.0 cents/month (.1315 cents per bushel per day).

The minimum storage charge, applicable freight and/or discounts will be invoiced November 30, 2024. Additional storage charges will be invoiced on 09/01/2025 or deducted from settlement if settled prior to that date. The minimum storage charge will be assessed and invoiced on unpriced old crop bushels on September 1, beginning with the 2024 crop.

SOYBEAN STORAGE CHARGES

Minimum Charge - 18 cents/bushel from harvest to December 1, 2024.

Thereafter, 5.0 cents/month (.1644 cents per bushel per day).

The minimum storage charge, applicable freight and/or discounts will be invoiced November 30, 2024. Additional storage charges will be invoiced on 09/01/2025 or deducted from settlement if settled prior to that date. A new minimum storage charge will be assessed and invoiced on unpriced old crop bushels on September 1, beginning with the 2024 crop. There will be a 1% shrink on all storage bushels.

GRAIN BANK CHARGES

6 cents per bushel minimum to December 1, 2024. Thereafter charges of 4.0 cents/month (.1315 cents/day) will apply on remaining bushels. Grain bank bushels removed or sold and not processed as feed, will be charged storage as described above. A new minimum storage charge and applicable freight and/or discounts will be invoiced when grain bank settlements are issued. Additional storage charges will be invoiced monthly.

IN/OUT CHARGES

In charge 8 cents/Out charge 8 cents. Only applies if grain is loaded out of storage or grain bank and not sold to RVC or ground through the feed mill.

PRICE LATER PROGRAMS

CORN/SOYBEAN PRICE LATER

Corn - for bushels delivered to River Valley locations only: Free until 9/30/24, then 18 cents/bushel to December 1, 2024. Thereafter 4 cents/month. Price by August 31, 2025.

Beans - for bushels delivered to River Valley locations only: Free until 9/30/24, then 24 cents/bushel to December 1, 2024. Thereafter 5.0 cents/month. Price by August 31, 2025.

Price Later charges, grain discounts and freight charges will be deducted from the settlement at the time of pricing.

CORN/SOYBEAN BASIS

A 70% Advance payout is available for grain settled to a basis contract upon receipt of a signed Basis Fixed Contract.

Grain discounts and freight charges associated with a Basis Contract will be deducted from the settlement at the time pricing.

Corn over 30% moisture is subject to rejection.

Shrink: 14.1% to 30.0% Shrink: **1.4%/point**

Corn delivered for storage under 15% will have no charge for drying

CORN - Contract/Spot/DP

Drying Charge: 15.1% to 18.0% Discount: **4.0 cents/point**Drying Charge: 18.1% to 22.0% Discount: **2.0 cents/point**Drying Charge: 22.1% to 30.0% Discount: **4.0 cents/point**

Corn over 30% moisture is subject to rejection.

Shrink: 15.1% to 30.0% Shrink: **1.4%/point**

SOYBEANS

Moisture discounts on all bushels above 13.0 will be \$0.10 per half % of moisture on all bushels priced at \$10.00 per bushel and below. \$10.01 and above, we will settle bushels at 1% of contract price per half.
